

Did you know that the <u>Fulbright Scholar Program</u> offers postdocs? Any U.S. citizen who has obtained their PhD within the last five years is eligible to apply.

This year, the program offers 18 exciting Postdoctoral Awards in 11 countries. Our postdocs provide scholars who have recently graduated with a fully-funded opportunity to research and train under faculty abroad. Alumni of the program have cited the dedicated research time and extended mentorship of these opportunities as the top assets of Fulbright's postdoctoral placements. Additionally, the professional network of fellow Fulbrighters and the prestige of the grant have opened doors for postdocs: after completing their grants, our scholars have gone on to succeed in tenure-track jobs, industry, and ongoing research and engagement in their field of study.
