GRADUATE STUDENT FINANCIAL AID APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

All financial assistance offered by the School of Medicine is based on financial need. As a student at a professional school, you are considered independent for federal financial aid and must submit financial information about yourself and your spouse.

You must be a United States citizen or permanent resident to apply for Federal Financial Aid at the School of Medicine.

REQUIRED APPLICATION MATERIAL

- 1. **FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid)**. All students except non-resident internationals are required to complete the application.
 - Complete the FAFSA electronically at <u>https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa</u>
 - <u>Renewal FAFSA</u>. If you filed a FAFSA or renewal FAFSA last year, you can save time by updating that data on the FAFSA renewal form for the coming award year. You will need your FSA ID (Username and password) to complete the application. Go to https://studentaid.gov/apply-for-aid/fafsa/renew for more information about the FSA ID. You may also call the Federal Student Aid Information Center at 1-800-4-FED-AID for assistance.
 - FAFSA school code <u>E00235</u> for Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine.
 - Maryland State residents applying for Maryland State scholarship funding must complete the FAFSA application by the March 1, State deadline.
- 2. **FEDERAL VERIFICATION WORKSHEET.** You will be required to complete this worksheet only if your FAFSA is selected for federal verification by the Department of Education. Your processed FAFSA Student Aid Report will indicate if your application has been selected.
