## MAVEN Project Overview

### OUR MISSION

The MAVEN Project seeks to bring expert healthcare within everyone's reach. We do this by connecting highly qualified volunteer physicians to underserved community clinics via telehealth technology.

### OUR PHYSICIAN VOLUNTEERS

- 35+ specialties including primary care
- Recently retired, semi-retired, in active practice or industry
- Active U.S. medical license, board certified/eligible, passed comprehensive credentialing process
- Culturally sensitive

### OUR CLINIC PARTNERS

- 8 States and expanding (CA, FL, MA, NY, PA, SC, SD, WA)
- Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs), free clinics and clinics dedicated to the uninsured and Medicaid from rural to inner-city America

### OUR SERVICES

The MAVEN Project offers three services, to support both underserved patients and the providers caring for them.

#### **ADVISORY CONSULTS**

Provider-to-provider consults in which primary care providers (PCPs) connect with our physician volunteers to discuss de-identified clinical cases. Our physician volunteers help PCPs validate or augment treatment plans, or appropriately triage cases to in-person specialists. PCPs connect with our volunteers via our dedicated platform and either schedules a time with preferred volunteer or in the case that a volunteer is available now, enters a waiting room for an on-demand consult.

#### **EDUCATIONAL SESSIONS**

Customized 45-minute presentations by our physician volunteers on relevant clinical topics framed for PCPs, followed by a 15-minute questions and answers session. Some sessions include CME credit. Example topics include opioid management, rheumatoid arthritis, abnormal uterine bleeding, and sports-related concussions.

#### **MENTORING**

Clinical mentoring and leadership coaching to support primary care providers. Clinical mentoring is a three-month program of regularly scheduled, one-on-one sessions between a clinic primary care provider (mentee) and a physician volunteer (mentor). The mentor and mentee can work on expertise and skill development, being a part of an interdisciplinary teams, career planning, or other goals as determined by the mentee. Leadership coaching provides ambulatory clinic leadership (mentee) access to volunteer mentors who have significant leadership experience for guidance and advice on managing a successful clinical practice, building a strong team, and managing and achieving their organization and its goals.
