Volunteering in Baltimore Area*

I currently volunteer for a Baltimore area nonprofit	31%

- The majority of respondents do not currently volunteer in Baltimore area community activities
- Half of respondents find the issues facing Baltimore important "to them"
- A small N are interested in the projects presented thus far at the Academy Meetings.

* N= 32, Response rate 37%



Interest in Specific Volunteer Activities

• Arts/culture		71%
• Higher education		59%
• Health care (community)		52%
• Environment		42%
• Youth development		43%
• K-12 Education (schools)		41%
• Human services (i.e. homeless)		39%
• Workforce development (job training)		21%
