For patients with a brain injury or tumor, the location of the lesion can make a difference in the symptoms they experience.

General brain tumor symptoms may include seizures, personality changes, nausea, headache and fatigue. **Specific symptoms may point to a problem in a particular area:**

Frontal Lobe

Personality
Movement
Sense of smell

Parietal Lobe

Identification of objects
Sense of pain and touch
Body navigation, spatial position

Occipital Lobe

Vision

Temporal Lobe

Memory
Speech
Musical rhythm

Pons

Control of eye and face movement

Medulla

Control of heart and lungs
