## Announcing the 2021 Junior Faculty Leadership Program (JFLP)!

**What is it?** Leadership course for junior faculty members in the School of Medicine. Nine, two-hour sessions addressing: leadership competencies; career-planning; negotiating; personality type; conflict; mentoring; communication; and promotion.

**When is it?** January – June (Wednesdays from 9am-11am; Jan. 6, Jan. 27, Feb. 17, March 10, March 31, April 21, April 28, May 26, June 2).

**How will it work?** Microsoft Teams (Teams is available to everyone at JH).

**Am I eligible?** Yes, if you are an Assistant Professor in the School of Medicine at rank more than one year, but less than five years.

**Why should I do it?** Because you will: increase your leadership knowledge; practice leadership skills; establish your leadership identity; and grow your community of colleague leaders.

**How do I apply?** There is no application this year. Registration will take place through myLearning. Watch your emails to register (Seating will be limited).

**What credit will I earn?** Participants who complete all nine sessions will earn a certificate of completion (missed sessions may be made-up in the subsequent year).

**Will there be opportunity for networking?** Yes, each session will include break-outs and we will also provide time to establish new collaborative and informal relationships.
