

Direct Pediatric Admissions to Johns Hopkins Bayview— Easy as 1, 2, 3!

For pediatric patients who need immediate medical attention and are stable for transport.

1. Call 410-955-9444, the Hopkins Access Line (HAL).
2. Ask for the **Johns Hopkins Bayview pediatric hospitalist** and discuss your case. This call is between you, the pediatric hospitalist and HAL operator. The HAL operator will tell you what you need to do, and give you instructions for your patient and transport details.
3. Send your patient to the Johns Hopkins Bayview admitting office.

Johns Hopkins Bayview Pediatric Hospitalist Service

The Johns Hopkins Bayview pediatric hospitalist service is responsible for the treatment of pediatric patients in both the emergency department and pediatric inpatient unit. The team includes physicians, physician assistants, nurse practitioners, registered nurses, nurse technicians, child life specialists and social workers.

To reach a pediatric hospitalist 24 hours a day, seven days a week, call 410-550-0100 and ask the operator to page the on-call pediatric hospitalist. To reach an administrative assistant during normal business hours, call 410-550-0963.
