Thank you for considering our manuscript entitled “Audit and Feedback in Nursing--An Evidence-Based Practice Literature Review” for publication. Our team started this work to better understand the science behind audit and feedback as a quality improvement strategy. While report cards are not a new concept, we noted a gap in the literature related to nursing specific electronic health record driven interventions and outcomes. This paper advances the understanding of evidence-based practices in quality improvement and their translation into the nursing population. We believe this would be of interest to frontline clinicians as well as managers and administrators who are accountable for nurse specific practice.

This review was completed using the Johns Hopkins Nursing Evidence-Based Practice Model and reported using the Evidence-Based Practice Process Quality Assessment as a guide.
