The Office of Johns Hopkins Physicians (OJHP) is proud to announce a competitive matching grant funding opportunity for innovation in 2017 for graduated Triads and Dyads of the Ambulatory Management Program (AMP).

### ***The Ambulatory Management Program: “Ambulatory Innovation Awards”***

The OJHP is pleased to support ***The Ambulatory Management Program: “Ambulatory Innovation Awards”*** to fund up to **10 matching grants in the \$5,000 to \$10,000 range.**

The **mission** of the OJHP is to assess the current state of Johns Hopkins physicians, examine unmet physician needs throughout the Johns Hopkins Medicine family, develop strategies for meeting current and unmet needs for Johns Hopkins physician services and ensure, in all such endeavors, that Johns Hopkins physicians are supported in a way that fosters Johns Hopkins’ tripartite mission.

To this end, the OJHP invites applications for grant support from all AMP alumnae groups in order to support the development of strategies to improve ambulatory operations and overall patient-and-family-centered care at JHM.

### **Purpose**

⚠ Implement innovative process to enhance patient-and family-centered delivery of care in the ambulatory setting, based on fundamentals previously developed in AMP, to offer a delightful experience to our patients and families, and to enhance the joy of the practice of clinical medicine for the care-giving team.

⚠ Examples might include innovative interventions related to:

- developing new models of clinical care delivery that improve quality of care, health outcomes, and / or cost
- enhancing patient satisfaction with clinical care
- supporting the well-being of those working in clinical care practice
- assessing the impact of emerging technologies in clinical care

### **Requirements:**

- ⚠ The applicant/principal investigator must be an alumnus of AMP.
- ⚠ The application must address the mission of the OJHP as stated above.

- ⚠ Commitment from department/organization to provide matching or greater financial support.

### **Priorities:**

Priority will be given to projects that:

- ⚠️ Directly support the mission objective of the AMP and OJHP to develop strategies to improve ambulatory operations at JHM.
- ⚠️ Have organizational/departmental support with letter of commitment in terms of a matching grant.

### **Guidelines:**

- ⚠️ Application
  - Page limit 5 pages maximum, single spaced, 12 point font
  - Sections:
    - Title Page with Title of Project, Clinical Champion and members of the project team (included in 8 page limit)
    - Background / Needs Assessment
    - Goals and Specific Measurable Objectives
    - Timeline
    - Key Stakeholders and Dependencies (e.g. Epic resources)
    - Intervention
    - Evaluation Methods: Describe the outcomes and variables that will be tracked and the plans for assessment of innovation.
    - Likely impact at Johns Hopkins Medicine (including expected products and plans for dissemination)
    - Budget and Budget Justification: State starting date (in most cases should not be later than May 1, 2017, and in no case later than July 1, 2017). (Funds may be used for Project expenses such as research assistant or statistical support, data entry, evaluation cost, etc.)
      - Funds may **NOT** be used for salary support, or for ongoing operational costs, or service recovery (i.e. parking tickets, café, gift certificates)
    - Relevance to the OJHP mission
- ⚠️ Relevant letters of support from division director or department whose clinical program(s) will be impacted by the innovative project (not included in ≤8 page limitation), and identifying commitment to matching support.
