The Department of Orthopaedic Surgery invites medical students who are women or members of underrepresented communities and are interested in pursuing a career in orthopaedic surgery to **apply for their 4th year medical student clerkship** at our institution.

SCHOLARSHIP INCLUDES:

One month clinical clerkship
Mentorship by Orthopaedic Surgery faculty member
Financial assistance*

Students must be eligible to participate in clinical rotations at their home medical school. Clerkships are only available to medical student attending LCME approved U.S. and Canadian medical schools, who are female or those who meet the AAMC definition of underrepresented minority groups. Once accepted, mentorship is provided by the Department of Orthopaedic Surgery faculty members during the clerkship, as well as financial assistance (*\$500 registration fee waiver, \$500 stipend for the month long rotation).
