Early Psychosis Intervention Clinic – Recovery After Initial Schizophrenia Episode (EPIC–RAISE) is a specialized program for adolescents and young adults, ages 13 to 30, who are having an initial psychotic episode or have been diagnosed with schizophrenia in the last two years. This includes:

- Hearing or seeing things that others do not see or hear
- Having unusual thoughts or beliefs that appear as strange to themselves or others
- Feeling fearful or suspicious of others, sometimes including others they usually trust
- Isolating themselves from family and friends

Mission

We use a coordinated specialty care approach to address the health and mental health needs of young adults, including providing support for co-occurring substance use disorders, metabolic issues and other co-occurring medical conditions. The EPIC–RAISE program is committed to reducing disability by equipping individuals at risk and their families with tools to manage their illness, move successfully through the developmental stages of growth and establish a life of their choosing.

Services

EPIC–RAISE offers a variety of comprehensive services to meet the unique needs of our patients and their families, including:

- Individual and family therapy
- Psychiatric evaluations
- Second opinion diagnostic consultations
- Psychological treatment
- Medication management
- Family support groups and education
- Targeted case management
- Supported employment and academic services
- Psychiatric Rehabilitation Program
- Other intensive levels of treatment, if needed
