



# ANOREXIA NERVOSA RESEARCH STUDY

Johns Hopkins researchers are conducting a placebo-controlled trial to examine the effectiveness of a research medication in the treatment of adults with anorexia nervosa. Participants will be offered 16 weeks of medication (active or inactive) and weekly outpatient medical monitoring by a psychiatrist. The treatment will be provided at no cost.

To participate, you must...

- Have anorexia nervosa
- Be 18-65 years old
- Be medically stable for outpatient treatment
- Be willing to complete assessments (interviews, questionnaires and medical evaluations) at intervals throughout the 16-week study and at 1- and 2-month follow-ups.
