

BYLAWS: **Professorial Promotions Committee (PPC)**

Responsibilities. The PPC is a standing committee of the Advisory Board of the Medical Faculty (ABMF) charged with evaluating and recommending candidates for new appointment or promotion to Professor for approval by ABMF. If the PPC does not approve an appointment or promotion, then it generally does not pass to the ABMF, unless the director exercises his option for ABMF review.

Membership. Membership of the PPC comprises at least 17 but no more than 35 members, all of whom are full Professors, with a broad participation from all departments. The members are appointed by the Dean for a five year term. Members may elect to continue on the PPC on an annual basis after their five year term is completed. There is no term limit for the PPC chair.

Meetings. The PPC meets at least 20 times a year, at least once monthly, on a variable schedule depending on workload, during September through June. It generally does not meet in July or August. Its meetings are currently 7-9 a.m. on Tuesday mornings in SOM 103 Boardroom.
