Steve Harr, M.D. is the President and CEO of Sana Biotechnology, a startup focused on cell therapy, gene therapy and gene editing with the goal of creating and delivering engineered cells as medicine for patients. Dr. Harr is the former chief financial officer for Juno Therapeutics, the company that developed CAR T-cell therapy to genetically reprogram a patient's immune cells. Before joining Juno, Dr. Harr was managing director and head of biotechnology investment banking at Morgan Stanley. Dr. Harr received his M.D. from the Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine before completing his internal medicine residency at UCSF.
