You are cordially invited to enjoy the facilities of the Mary Elizabeth Garrett Room. This room is for the exclusive use of the women medical and graduate students and physicians of The Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine and Hospital.

The Appendix of The Johns Hopkins University Circular - School of Medicine documents the important role played by Miss Garrett and her friends in the history of the School of Medicine. The Women's Fund Committee provided the funds which enabled the School to be established, and conditioned their gift on 1) the requirement of an excellent standard of premedical education and 2) the assurance that women would be accepted on the same terms as men.

The Garrett Room is located on Halsted 1, Room 106, in The Johns Hopkins Hospital just off the corridor connecting the main corridor with the Harvey/Nelson Tower Building. It consists of a lounge, which was recently refurbished, attached locker room, and rest rooms. The Johns Hopkins Women's Medical Alumnae Association (JHWMAA) Hall of Fame is also located in this room. It is hoped that you will use the Room frequently - to study, to relax, and to get acquainted with other women of the Johns Hopkins Medical community. The JHWMAA will be planning events there through the year.
