Dear Postdoctoral Fellow:

In order to comply with regulatory guidelines, it is important for you to understand that a fellowship appointment in the School of Medicine does not entitle you to practice medicine at The Johns Hopkins Hospital or affiliated clinical sites, nor does it entitle you to professional liability coverage.

If participating in patient care activities or human subjects research is part of your fellowship training, you must apply for and be granted a clinical fellow appointment at The Johns Hopkins Hospital or at an affiliated clinical site. An application packet can be obtained from the clinical department in which you plan to carry out clinical activities. It should be noted the credentialing process can take up to three months to complete.


