2011- present Medical Director of Wilmer at Odenton, The satellite has grown tremendously since 2011 with annual visits now exceeding 14,000. The clinic draws patients from Anne Arundel County, southern Maryland, the Eastern Shore, Delaware and Virginia and provides comprehensive eye care as well as specialty care in cornea, oculoplastics, medical retina and uveitis.
