New Prior Authorization Requirements For Certain Provider-Administered Medications

Effective Date: April 1, 2023

Health Plan(s) Affected: Johns Hopkins Employer Health Programs (EHP)

Type of Change: Process

Explanation of Change:

Effective April 1, 2023, Johns Hopkins HealthCare will require prior authorization to determine medical necessity for several provider-administered medications under the EHP health plan. This requirement affects members of all ages.
