

## Recent Changes to COVID-19 Coverage for USFHP

**Effective Date:** April 18, 2023

**Health Plans Affected:** Johns Hopkins US Family Health Plan (USFHP)

**Type of Change:** Benefit

### Explanation of Change:

Effective April 18, 2023 for USFHP members, the monovalent Moderna and Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccines are no longer authorized for use in the United States, and the below vaccine codes are no longer covered by USFHP:

- 0001A, 0002A, 0003A, 0004A, 0011A, 0012A, 0013A, 0051A, 0052A, 0053A, 0054A, 0064A, 0071A, 0072A, 0073A, 0074A, 0081A, 0082A, 0083A, 0091A, 0092A, 0093A, 0094A, 0111A, 0112A, 0113A, 91300, 91301, 91305, 91306, 91307, 91308, 91309, 91311.

### New Codes

The following new codes have been added to the vaccine benefit and require no referral or prior authorization.

- 0121A, 0141A, 0142A, 0151A, 0171A, 0172A

### Telehealth

All providers must now use HIPAA-compliant telehealth platforms, effective May 12, 2023, the day after the expiration of the Public Health Emergency (PHE).
